Singapore startup Peptobiotics, competing in the Environment, Energy & Green Technologies domain, emerged Grand Winner at SLINGSHOT 2022 amid competition from over 3,600 global startups

10 winners across various deep tech domains; more than S\$1.2 million worth of grants and prizes awarded.

- 1. Peptobiotics emerged the winner of the grand prize at the finals of SLINGSHOT 2022 today, organised by Enterprise Singapore (EnterpriseSG). The startup from Singapore stood out for its innovative synthetic biology alternative to livestock antibiotics. Competing in the Environment, Energy & Green Technologies challenge domain, Peptobiotics aims to leverage advances in both human medicine and synthetic biology to create an antibiotic-free agricultural system. The first runner-up was E3A Healthcare and second runner-up was Wasna, which both competed in the Healthcare and Biomedical challenge domain.
- 2. Two domain winners were awarded for their outstanding solutions across each of the challenge domains, i) Manufacturing, Trade & Connectivity, ii) Health & Biomedical, iii) Environment, Energy & Green Technologies, iv) Transformative Digital Technologies, and v) Consumer Media, Goods & Services. The top 10 domain winners were awarded a S\$50,000 Startup SG grant each.
- 3. The Grand Winner took home an additional S\$200,000 Startup SG grant on top of the domain prize, and 18 months of rent-free space at JTC Launchpad. First runner-up E3A Healthcare received an additional S\$150,000 Startup SG grant, while second runner-up Wasna received an additional S\$100,000 Startup SG grant; they also received 12 and 6 months of rent-free space at JTC Launchpad respectively. Winners stand to get support from EnterpriseSG to expand their business operations in Singapore (Refer to Annex for details of winners).

- 4. The sixth edition of SLINGSHOT attracted over 3,600 startup applicants from more than 150 markets, including leading startup hubs such as Israel, Germany, South Korea, the United Kingdom, the United States and Vietnam. Asia as a whole saw increased participation this year, accounting for 55% of applications as compared to 31% in 2021.
- 5. The top 50 finalists went through an intense three-day finals, culminating in a final live pitching session by the top 10 before a judging panel comprising renowned international players from venture firms such as Antler, East Ventures, Sequoia Capital and Vertex Ventures. The finalists put forth solutions to address both market gaps and larger social issues as part of Asia's premier deep tech startup competition.
- 6. Mr Peter Ong, Chairman, EnterpriseSG, who was a judge at the grand finals and gave out the prizes today, said "The finalists we saw today offered innovative solutions that have the potential to address important industry and societal concerns. To help them and more startups execute their innovative solutions, we must work together with partners to give them the right resources and support. With upcoming global headwinds and a more cautious investor climate, access to financing, talent and connections will be particularly important."

Startups access collaboration and networking opportunities in-person

7. The top 50 finalists gained valuable insights through an inaugural one-week inperson immersion programme to understand the landscape in Singapore and support they stand to gain to scale their businesses from here. The workshops and networking sessions gave them access to potential investors, corporate partners and community enablers across the ecosystem, including private sector enablers such as Amazon Web Services (AWS), Baker McKenzie, Catapult at Rochester Commons, Google, deep tech VC SOSV, key associations such as Action Community for Entrepreneurship (ACE) and SGTech, Institutes of Higher Learning such as NUS Enterprise and SMU Institute of Innovation & Entrepreneurship, as well as government agencies such as the Agency for Science, Technology and Research (A*STAR) and JTC. In particular, the startups attended an exclusive networking session with over 20 investors, went through pitch coaching and mentoring, and visited research, innovation and corporate facilities.

8. Past winners of SLINGSHOT have made their mark on the Singapore startup scene.

Since 2017, the top 40 SLINGSHOT winners have gone on to raise more than S\$560

million in investments, post-SLINGSHOT. One example is QuantumCyte, the 2021

Grand Winner, which has since set up an office at JTC Launchpad @ Block 81.

QuantumCyte is now completing clinical trials with Singapore General Hospital

(SGH) for undiagnosable, late stage, metastatic lung and colorectal cancers.

Singapore patients will be the first in the world to benefit from these groundbreaking

cancer tests.

Ms Bernadine Lim, Chief Commercial Officer and Co-Founder, QuantumCyte, said 9.

"Being crowned the 2021 SLINGSHOT Grand Winner allowed us to hire key

personnel and support the clinical trials at SGH, as well as grow our collaboration

capabilities with clinicians, scientists and researchers in Singapore. With the support

of EnterpriseSG, we were connected to the Biomedical Sciences Industry

Partnership Office (BMS IPO), the Genome Institute of Singapore (GIS), National

Cancer Centre Singapore (NCCS), A*STAR, and SingHealth to rapidly build our

customer pipeline. SLINGSHOT provided us with an incredible platform to showcase

our technology, and has already opened doors to other parts of Southeast Asia. With

EnterpriseSG's continued support, we plan to expand our presence in the region,

and create "Made in Singapore" products to be sold globally."

10. SLINGSHOT, powered by Startup SG, is EnterpriseSG's marquee deep tech startup

pitching competition that provides startups with an international platform to profile

themselves to corporates, industry veterans and investors. The finals took place as

part of the SWITCH flagship event taking place from 25 to 28 October 2022. For

By leveraging advances in human medicine and synthetic biology, they are creating a new class of feed additives that can maximise animal welfare, gut health, feed conversion and growth with comparable performance to antibiotics – without creating drug resistant superbugs.
2.	SLINGSHOT 2022 First Runner-Up – E3A Healthcare Health and Biomedical	E3A Healthcare creates first-in-class medical products and services for newborn and women's health that tackle overlooked healthcare demands in areas including fertility management, pelvic health, and neonatal jaundice.
3.	SLINGSHOT 2022 Second Runner-Up Wansa Health and Biomedical	The biggest challenge facing the biotech industry is its high costs. Optimising costs of cell culture medium formulations is critical to achieving commercial success. Wasna produces animal-free growth serum that is safe, ethical, and cost-effective.
