# FACTSHEET ON SME TALENT PROGRAMME (STP) - SME

The SME Talent Programme (STP) aims to help local SMEs attract talent from the Institute of Technical Education (ITE), Polytechnics and Universities, through structured and meaningful student internships.

The programme is an initiative by Enterprise Singapore, in partnership with participating STP Approved-in-Principle (AIP) partners, ITE, Polytechnics and Universities. The appointed STP AIP Partners are the key managing partners of this initiative to recruit talent for growing SMEs across industries.

**STP** supports SMEs' efforts in providing meaningful internship opportunities for full-time local students. Through industry exposure, students receive a better understanding of working in SMEs. This is to assist SMEs in building a talent pool for future recruitment possibilities.

#### Eligibility criteria for students

Interns must be Singapore citizens or Singapore Permanent Residents, and full-time students from ITE, NYP, NP, RP, SP, TP, NTU, NUS, SUSS, SIT, SMU or SUTD.

The computation for the monthly allowance shall be based on the number of working days in a month. ^^Actual internship period is supported based on internship placement letters issued by the respective IHLs and are submitted to Enterprise Singapore or its partners. Eligible grant support for SMEs is calculated at 70% of the fixed minimum internship allowance. Eligible grant support for non-SMEs is calculated at 30% of the fixed minimum internship allowance.
